

"My coach, Bruce Frankie, and my mom advised me not to accept the movie offer right now," explained Gea. Even though there was a lot of money involved, they felt it wouldn't be in my best interest — that it would get in the way of my track career. We're hoping that there will be another picture offer for me at a later date. It would really be fun!"

So for the moment, Gea Johnson will concentrate on track & field training; and there might be other sacrifices she'll have to make between now and the 1988 Olympics. If so, Gea figures it'll be worth it. For the moment, track is number one for Gea.

This sunny 18-year old beauty has an unlimited amount of drive & determination to reach her goals; and an abundance of natural talent to achieve them. With this combination, Gea Johnson has already begun to make a name for herself. Whether it be as a movie celebrity, an Olympic champion, or both — Gea John-
